TWO. OVERVIEW



WHAT IS THE NORTHEAST ASIAN MAYORS' FORUM (NEAMF)?

The Northeast Asian Mayors' Forum was first initiated by the Ulaanbaatar City Government in 2014 and successfully organized with the support of the Asia Foundation. It has been operating continuously since then. There were three forums and one thematic meeting held in the past which gathered delegates from over 40 cities in six Northeast Asian countries – the People's Republic of China, the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Japan, Mongolia, the Republic of Korea, and the Russian Federation – to discuss solutions and share experiences on the pressing issues among the cities.

In recent years, Asian cities have experienced the highest urbanization rates in the world, and by 2030, nearly 57 percent of Asia's population is expected to live in urban areas. Therefore, along with the rapid growth of urbanization, there is dire need for proper management on many issues including urban planning, air and soil pollution, waste management, efficiency use of energy, and good governance.

The main purpose of the Forum is not only to exchange ideas, innovative experiences and solutions to the above issues the cities in the region are facing but also to strengthen regional cooperation development.

NEAMF MISSION



To serve as a permanent and multifaceted mechanism for the development of cooperation between the cities of the Northeast Asian region



To promote the best practices, new and advanced technologies from the participant cities in solving the common urban issues



To implement joint projects and initiatives aimed at expanding regional cooperation in economic, social, environmental, energy, infrastructure and urban planning fields





NEAMF'S IMMEDIATE OBJECTIVES

To lay down the legal basis for institutionalization of the NEAMF as a permanent mechanism through developing and adopting of such founding documents as Charter and Rules of Procedure to establish its organizational structure, membership rules, and financing regulations

To develop and adopt respective operational documents such as Internal Rules and Staff Regulations for the Secretariat which is to provide professional support to the NEAMF

To develop cooperation with other organizations in Asia and globally as a permanent mechanism to promote interaction and cooperation among the cities in Northeast Asia



THREE. NORTHEAST ASIAN MAYORS' FORUM SECRETARIAT

BRIEF INTRODUCTION

The participant cities from the third NEAMF, organized in Ulaanbaatar city in 2018, decided to establish the NEAMF Secretariat under the Ulaanbaatar City Government. Thus, the Ulaanbaatar City Government with the support of the Asia Foundation commenced the North East Asian Mayors' Forum Secretariat operations since September 2020.

The main mission of the NEAMF Secretariat is to provide professional support to the regular functioning of the Forum, to develop draft procedural, policy and research documents for adoption and implementation, and to help mobilize more and active involvement of member cities.

Regularize NEAMF activities and provide up to date information to the participant cities and mobilize cities' participation

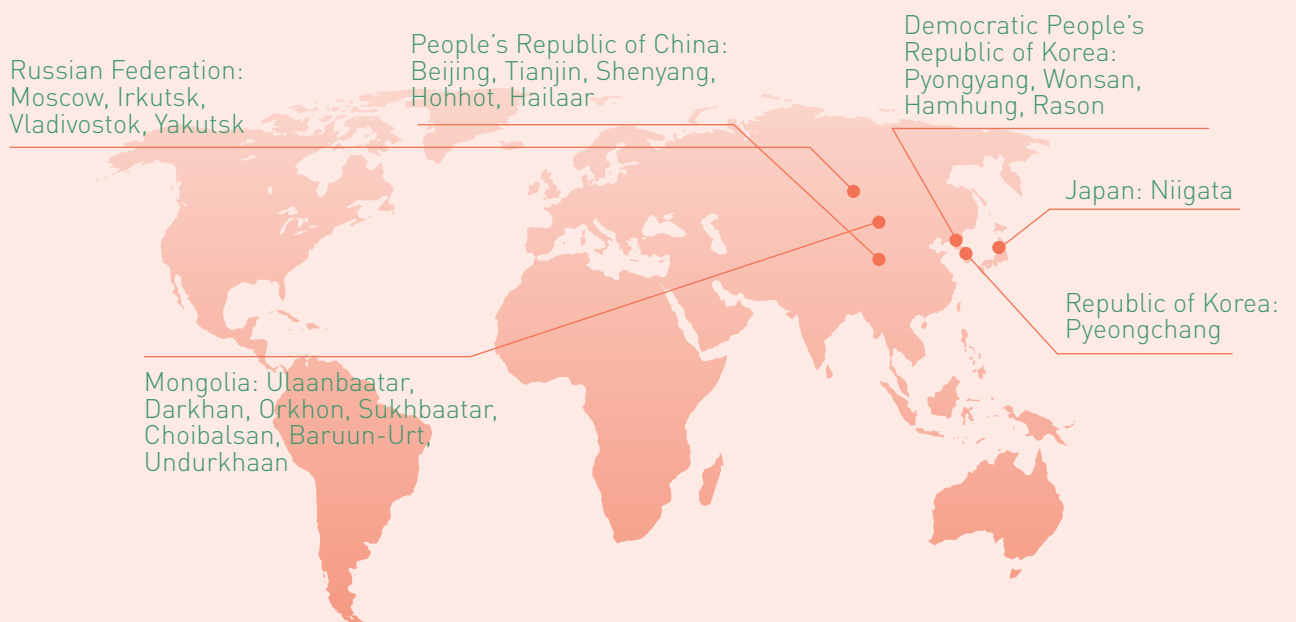

The Northeast Asian Mayors' Forum (NEAMF) convened in Ulaanbaatar, capital city of Mongolia, on 18-19 August 2014 to discuss the issue of "Sustainable and Inclusive Cities" with the initiative of the Ulaanbaatar City Government with the support of the Asia Foundation.

This year's forum saw a total number of 120 delegates including the city mayors and officials from 22 cities from 6 different countries, the policy makers from Mongolian government offices, and local administrations as well as the embassies and international organizations in Ulaanbaatar city. The participants exchanged views and experiences of cities in the Northeast Asia region on the urban issues such as city governance, environmental, and green development.

The forum had four main sessions with 7 presentations from the participant cities and 8 presentations from the international organizations.

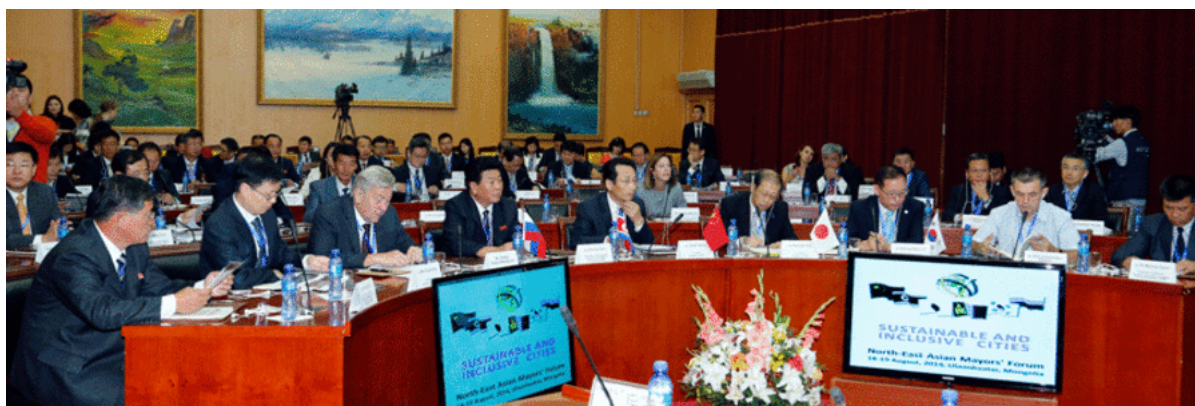

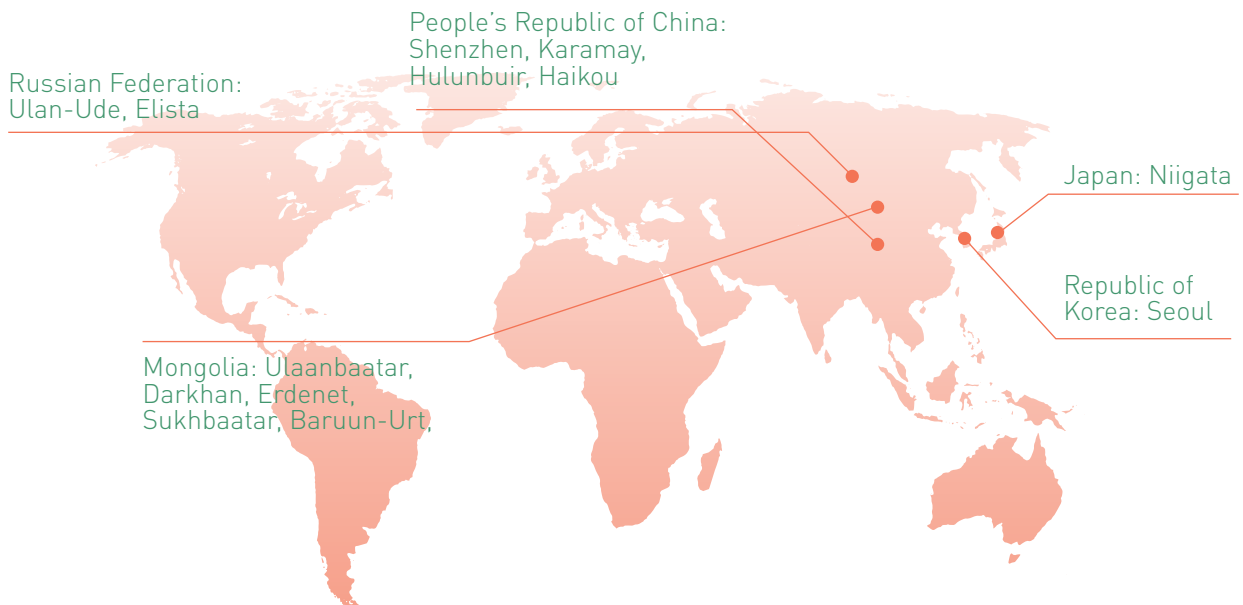

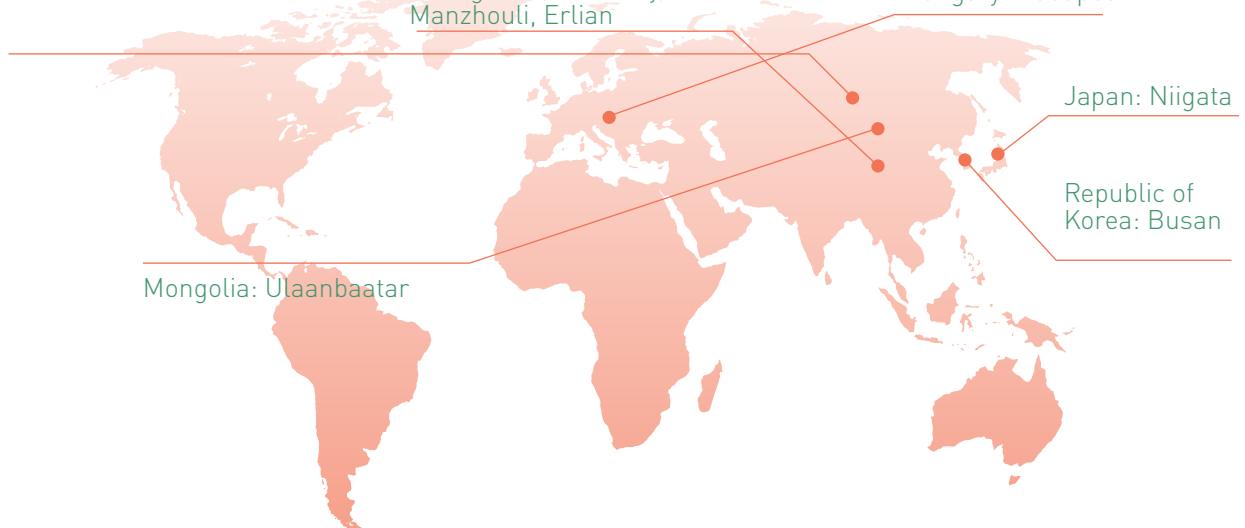

THE THIRD NORTHEAST ASIAN MAYORS' FORUM – 2018

THEME: Low Carbon City Development: Improving Air Quality and Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions

DATE: 17-19 June 2018

HOST CITY: The Ulaanbaatar City Government with the support of the Asia Foundation

The third Northeast Asian Mayors' Forum convened in Ulaanbaatar, capital city of Mongolia, on 17-19 June 2018 under "Low Carbon City Development: Improving Air Quality and Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions" theme to exchange views and experiences of cities in the Northeast Asia region on this subject and to strengthen regional cooperation.

This year's forum saw a total number of 210 delegates including the city mayors and officials from 17 cities from 6 different countries, the policy makers from Mongolian government offices, and local administrations as well as the embassies and international organizations in Ulaanbaatar city. Participants discussed about the climate change issues and greenhouse gas emission and shared their city practices on the solution.

The forum had three main plenary sessions with the city delegates and international organization representatives' presentations.

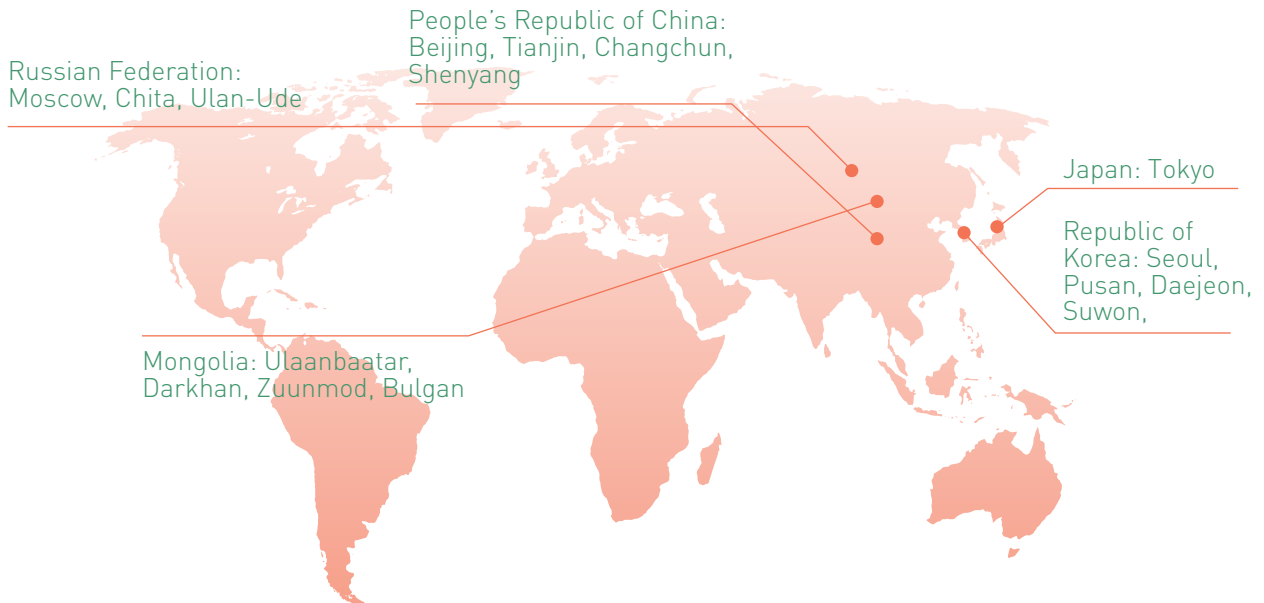
NEAMF 2018 OUTCOME:

Upon sharing views and exchanging best practice solutions on three main plenary "Key Policy Challenges and Solutions for Low Carbon Development in the Region", "Low Carbon Technology Solution and Best Practices" and "North-East Asian Mayor's Forum: A Way Forward and Organizational Issues", participants made following decisions:

- In order to sustain NEAMF operations, establish NEAMF Secretariat under Ulaanbaatar City Government office upon their initiation. Moreover, participants agreed to organize NEAMF in Ulaanbaatar city every four years as the city is the NEAMF initiative.
- Assign role on Ulaanbaatar City Government office to set the NEAMF rules and regulations as well as the project to start NEAMF Secretariat work to be confirmed at the 4th NEAMF.
- According to the participants secret ballot, the Seoul Metropolitan Government, Republic of Korea was selected as the 4th NEAMF hosting city as a result of competing for the host city award with Chanchung city government, People's Republic of China.
